

Certification and Accreditation Professional (CAP)

The Certification and Accreditation Professional (CAP) credential is an objective measure of the knowledge, skills and abilities required for personnel involved in the process of certifying and accrediting the security of information systems. Specifically, the credential applies to professionals responsible for formalizing processes used to assess risk and establish security requirements, as well as ensure information systems possess security commensurate with the level of exposure to potential risk.

Who Should Attend:

Information Systems Security professionals who must possess and demonstrate the necessary knowledge, skills, and abilities and experience to effectively monitor and evaluate a company's security risks and requirements. The CAP credential is aimed at information assurance (IA) professionals who have a responsibility for adherence to NIST (National Institute of Standards and Technology) guidelines.

Prerequisite for Exam:

Candidates for the CAP must meet several requirements; Applicants must have a minimum of two years of direct full-time information systems security certification and accreditation professional work experience in one or more of the five domains of the ISC² CAP CBK.

Candidates who take the exam must submit an examination application with the required \$369.00 fee. The application may be downloaded from the ISC² website at www.isc2.org.

Candidates must have a minimum of two years of professional experience in information assurance, certification and accreditation.

Each candidate must attest to the truth of their assertions regarding professional experience and accept the ISC² Code of Ethics.

Applicants must answer four questions relative to criminal history and related background.

Each successful candidate must pass the CAP exam with a scaled score of 700 points or greater. The exam consists of 150 questions to be answered over a period of four hours.

After passing the exam, each candidate must have their qualifications endorsed by another qualified professional. The endorser attests that the candidate's assertions regarding professional experience are true to the best of their knowledge, and that the candidate is in good standing within the information security industry.
