Certified Information Systems Security Professional (CISSP)

Prerequisites for Exam:

Candidates for the CISSP must meet several requirements:

Candidates must have a minimum of four years of professional experience in information security. One year of experience may be waived for having three years information security experience plus a college degree in Information Security.

Candidates who take the exam must submit an examination application with the required \$500 fee. The application may be downloaded from the ISC² website at www.isc2.org.

Each candidate must attest to the truth of their assertions regarding professional experience and accept the CISSP Code of Ethics.

Applicants must answer four questions relative to criminal history and related background.

Each successful candidate must pass the CISSP exam with a scaled score of 700 points or greater. The exam consists of 250 questions to be answered over a period of six hours.

After passing the exam, each candidate must have their qualifications endorsed by another CISSP or other qualified professional. The endorser attests that the candidate's assertions regarding professional experience are true to the best of their knowledge, and that the candidate is in good standing within the information security industry.
