Course Length: 5 days.

Prerequisite for Exam:

This course is critical for any student attempting this certification exam. SSCP is included as one of the required courses in technical levels I and II of the DoD 8570.1 directive. Candidates for the SSCP must meet several requirements:

Candidates who take the exam must submit an examination application with the required \$369.00 fee. The application may be downloaded from the ISC² website at www.isc2.org.

Candidates must have a minimum of one year of professional experience in information security.

Each candidate must attest to the truth of their assertions regarding professional experience and accept the ISC² Code of Ethics.

Applicants must answer four questions relative to criminal history and related background.

Each successful candidate must pass the SSCP exam with a scaled score of 700 points or greater. The exam consists of 150 questions to be answered over a period of four hours.

After passing the exam, each candidate must have their qualifications endorsed by another qualified professional. The endorser attests that the candidate's assertions regarding professional experience are true to the best of their knowledge, and that the candidate is in good standing within the information security industry.
